



First e-charging station in Skopje

On 09th of July 2015 the Mayor of the City of Skopje Mr. Koce Trajanovski and the director of the PE "City Parking – Skopje" Mr. Borche Jakimovski officially put in operation the first echarging station in Skopje, located in the city center multi-storey parking garage "Makedonska Falanga" (1st floor).

- This station is designed for charging electric vehicles of all types (car, scooter, electric bike) and it has two ports for simultaneous charging with a total power of 22 kW (kilo watt) per connection. The parking during charging in multi-storey garage "Makedonska Falanga" is free for every owner of electric vehicles. The City of Skopje will continue with projects that promote eletromobility and in the near future will be purchased an electric vehicle for the administration of the City of Skopje, but also we will continue to support the process of setting these e-charging stations together with the PE "City Parking" said Mayor Trajanovski.

The installation of this e-charging station is the first of its kind in Skopje and currently the PE "City Parking" has purchased two stations for charging electric vehicles for the amount of 20,000€ (10,000€ each station).











Within the promotional event regarding the launch of the first station for charging electric vehicles in Skopje, ProCredit Bank AD Skopje launched their 5 new e-vehicles (*Volkswagen e-up*) purchased for use in daily operations, therefore becoming the first company in Macedonia that uses e-vehicles.

The Mayor of the City of Skopje, Mr. Koce Trajanovski, awarded Certificate of gratitude for special contribution to the development and promotion of electromobility in Skopje:

- ProCredit Bank AD Skopje (the first company in Macedonia that has purchased 5 e-vehicles for use in daily operations)
- Mr. Vancho Zrncev (individual innovative conversion of conventional vehicle Matis into electric)
- Mr. Sasho Jovanovski (individual innovative conversion of conventional vehicle Cinquecento into electric)
