

Charging stations for electric vehicles start work in five public garages

July, 15, 2015. The City of Zagreb mayor, Mr Milan Bandić has officially opened the charging station for electric vehicles in the Tuškanac public garage. The opening was also attended by the head of Zagrebparking and numerous reporters. Zagrebparking is the company that manages public garages in the City of Zagreb.

The Tuškanac charging station is one of five charging stations that Zagrebparking has included in the Zagreb public garages. The charging stations have been opened in the following public garages: - public garage Langov trg, Langov trg bb - public garage Petrinjska, Petrinjska

public garage Tuškanac, Tuškanac
public garage Kvaternikov trg,
Kvaternikov trg bb
public garage Gorica, Martićeva 69

The project "Charging stations for electric vehicles in the Zagrebparking public garages" has co-financed been bv the Environmental Protection and Energy Efficiency Fund in the amount of 40%, as part of the program for the cleaner transport of the Ministry of Environmental and Nature Protection, while 60% is financed through own funds. Total value of the investment amounts to 160.000 HRK.

Each garage has installed one charging station which allows for simultaneous charging of two electric vehicles. Use of charging stations is free of charge.

The owner of the electric vehicle pays the same amount for the daily parking ticket as other users, but the price of the prepaid ticket for parking hybrid and electric vehicles in all garages is 50% less as compared to the price of the prepaid ticket for conventional vehicles.

Through introducing charging stations in five public garages, Zagrebparking wishes to support the protection of the environment by encouraging ecological consciousness in citizens. The use of electric vehicles will allow for a cleaner city, without the polluting exhaust fumes as well as a lower noise level and a better quality of life for citizens.







